It was back to business as usual yesterday after last week's successful lamb show and feature sale.

### LAMBS

Lambs sold to \$185 (\$191) for heavy lambs (pictured top left) off the oats and lucerne sold by B&S on account Garry and Sally Burgess. Shorn lambs sold to \$147 (\$200) and young lambs sold to \$150 (\$128) with top price going to Hombsch selling through DCM. Other highlights included lambs (pictured 2<sup>nd</sup> from top) sold by IML on account Tarwarri, Nundle for \$165. The top Dorper lambs (pictured bottom left) made \$138 and were sold by CP.



### SHEEP

Ewes and lambs sold to \$110 (\$200) for mixed age Dorper ewes sold by ELD on account Dawn McDonald. 293 (611) ewes sold to \$130 (\$129) and averaged \$76 (\$75); wethers sold to \$132 (\$137) and averaged \$86 (\$108) with 633 (140) sold and 16 (30) rams sold to \$112 (\$106) and averaged \$80 (\$68).
