



DEMAND MAKES FOR DEARER TRENDS

Strong demand led to a higher prices for light and medium weight steers and heifers with vealer steers hitting 400c/kg for the second time this year.

STEERS

Vealer steers sold to 400c/kg (369c/kg), yearlings sold to 396c/kg (354c/kg) and grown steers sold to 329c/kg (321c/kg).

Angus vealer steers (pictured top left) sold by PSPF on account Pieter Muusers, “Fallsview” Walcha made 376c/kg and averaged 285kg/\$1070;

Angus steers sold by ELD on account TJ & MA Wyatt made 374c/kg and averaged 266kg/\$995;

Angus/Angus x vealer steers (pictured 2nd from top) old by B&S on account J & J Buggy made 366c/kg and averaged 259kg/\$948;

Hereford vealer steers sold by IML on account Emu Hills Partnership made 357c/kg and averaged 241kg/\$860;

Vealer heifers sold to 340c/kg (335c/kg), yearlings sold to 323c/kg (321c/kg) and grown heifers sold to 294c/kg (302c/kg).

Highlights included:

Angus vealer heifers (pictured top left) sold by PSPF on account Pieter Muusers, “Fallsview” Walcha made 323c/kg and averaged 285kg/\$1070;

Charolais x heifers (pictured middle left) sold by CP on account RJ Laurie, Nowendoc made 323c/kg and came back at 380kg/\$1228;

Vealer heifers sold by G&C on account A & K Mahony, “Prestwick” made 318c/kg and averaged 400kg/\$1272;

Angus vealer heifers sold by PSPF on account Lafforgue made 314c/kg and averaged 350kg/\$1100; and

COWS

Cows sold to 239c/kg (246c/kg).

BULLS

Bulls sold to 277c/kg (296c/kg) for an Angus bull sold by PSPF on account Salter. He weighed 1025kg for a return of \$2841 with another bull from the same vendor making 268c/kg and coming back at 970kg/\$2600. They were both beaten on price by a bull sold by IML on account BD & ME Wellings, “Mygunyah”, Walcha made 275c/kg and came back at 1070kg/\$2942.
