

## From the Sheep Yards



### Lambs

Young lambs sold to \$145 (\$149) with top price for Dorper suckers (pictured top) sold by CPL on account M & D Morawitz; older lambs sold to \$170 (\$151) with top price shared by Dunmore (pictured middle left) selling through LMK and Kelly for their lambs (pictured bottom left) sold through PPA; shorn lambs sold to \$158 (\$130) with top price going to Ballantine; and hoggets sold to \$102 (\$131). Other highlights included a run of 88 suckers sold by Pitt on account Maryland for \$119. There were good numbers of store lambs with re-stocker demand pushing prices up to \$5/head dearer.



### Sheep

892 ewes sold to \$110 (\$110) and averaged \$68 (\$76); 326 wethers sold to \$98 (\$105) and averaged \$85 (\$76); 40 rams sold to \$70 (\$60) and averaged \$42 (\$52). The best Dorper lambs made \$161 (\$143) and were sold by PPA.
