

From the Sheep Yards

It was cold wet and windy at Tamworth yesterday with a decrease in both lamb and sheep numbers and most classes cheaper from previous weeks.



LAMBS

Lambs sold to \$155 (\$164) with top price shared between 70+kg lambs (pictured top left) sold by NLP on account Clonagh Pastoral Co and March/April drop, 72+kg lambs (pictured bottom left) also sold by NLP on account R & N Spark. Shorn lambs sold to \$150 (\$148) and young lambs sold to \$148 (\$152) with top price going to Banoon Pastoral Co for the second week, selling through G&C.



SHEEP

527 (1145) ewes sold to \$100 (\$127) and averaged \$64 (\$82); \$116 (435) wethers sold to \$110 (\$122) and averaged \$73 (\$98) and 34 (21) rams sold to \$70 (\$108) and averaged \$62 (\$82). The best Dorper lambs made \$132 and were sold by B&S.
