

MARKET FIRM TO DEARER IN A VERY STRONG HEIFER MARKET

Numbers increased slightly this week with the best price gains for feeder and re-stocker cattle, particularly for heifers that rose by as much as 26c/kg.



STEERS

Vealer steers sold to 388c/kg (384c/kg), yearlings to 386c/kg (377c/kg) and grown steers to 361c/kg (378c/kg).

- Heavy Red Angus steers sold by DCM made 290c/kg and averaged 700kg/\$2030;
- Angus steers sold by DCM on account Kea Farms made 355c/kg and averaged 509kg/\$1807;
- Yearling steers sold by LMK on account D & JN Smith made 379c/kg and averaged 469kg/\$1777;
- Angus yearling steers (pictured above) sold by IML on account Lockaway Pastoral Co sold to 379c/kg and averaged 353kg/\$1342 with the heaviest pen making 377c/kg and averaging 415kg/\$1567;

Vealer heifers sold to 350c/kg (342c/kg), yearling heifers to 360c/kg (358c/kg) and grown heifers to 342c/kg (315c/kg). Highlights included:

- Charolais x Shorthorn heifers (pictured below left) sold by IML on account PR & BC Doyle, made 360c/kg at estimated 400kg/\$1440;
- Yearling Charolais heifers sold by DCM on account Peter Blake sold to 343c/kg and averaged 388kg/\$1327 with the 4 tooth selling to 298c/kg for the lightweight and the heavier heifers making 282c/kg and averaging 434kg/\$1224;
- Yearling heifers sold by G&C on account CR & RE Clifton made 359c/kg and averaged 351kg/\$1260;
- Angus heifers sold by PSPF on account Yarnold made 339c/kg and averaged 363kg/\$1230;
