Other good results included: new season lambs sold by DCM on account Bowler for \$150; 50-54kg lambs sold by B&S on account Bede Burke made \$145; and suckers straight off their mothers, sold by Pitt on account Vincent made \$140.

SHEEP

345 (456) ewes sold to \$105 (\$150) for 1st x and Dorper ewes and averaged \$82 (\$80); 671 (253) wethers sold to \$124 (\$120) and averaged (\$83); 25 (81) rams sold to \$80 (\$89) and averaged \$67 (\$68). Rising 2 yr old restocker Merino wethers sold by Pitt on account Europambla made \$70.50 Some very good Dorper lambs sold well including: heavy Dorper lambs (pictured below) sold by PPA made \$143; lambs off the Lucerne sold by G&C on account Webber and Newton made \$126; and outstanding Dorper hoggets (pictured below right) sold by PPA made \$122.50.
