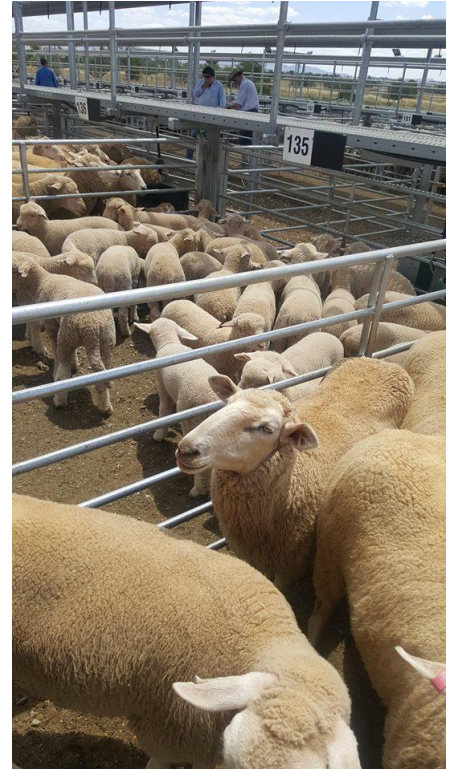


From the Sheep Yards

Numbers increased again this week with one agent saying it's the best quality yarding he's seen at TRLX for some time in a generally dearer market.



LAMBS

Young lambs sold to \$150 (\$154) with top price for 48-52kg suckers sold by CP on account Wendouree Grazing. Older lambs (pictured above left) sold to \$163.50 (\$151) and were sold by PPA on account Dennis Frost. Other good results included shorn lambs sold by CP on account Wahnica for \$156.

SHEEP

Ewes and lambs (pictured above middle and right) sold to \$151 for 1st x ewes joined to Dorset rams sold by DCM on account Max Moffatt, Duri. Older ewes sold to \$115 (\$105) and averaged \$80 (\$82); wethers sold to \$105 (\$124) for Merino wethers and averaged \$84 (\$83); rams sold to \$75 (\$80) and averaged \$61 (\$67).
