

From the Sheep Yards



Sheep numbers were well down on last week and there was a very good market for extra heavy lambs that sold to \$200.

Lambs

Young lambs sold to \$160 (\$176) with top price for suckers sold by CP; older lambs sold to \$200 (\$180) with top price for 60+kg lambs (pictured above) sold by LMK on account of the Boydell family; shorn lambs sold to \$185 (\$158) for lambs (pictured below left) sold by G&C on account KR & JF Tongue; and hoggets sold to \$115 (\$110). Other good sales included \$194 for lambs (pictured below right) sold by CP on account Daryl Reading; \$180 for lambs sold by CP on account Wendouree; \$177 lambs sold by NLP on account Greg Stones; suckers sold by DCM on account Hombsch made \$155; and shorn suckers sold by B&S on account Burke Pastoral made \$150. Sept drop White Suffolk x Merino lambs (pictured bottom left) sold by DCM topped at \$97.



Sheep

790 (1893) ewes sold to \$111 (\$154) and averaged \$84 (\$82); 341 (1357) wethers sold to \$112 (\$120) and averaged \$97 (\$76); 73 (71) rams sold to \$90 (\$129) and averaged \$62 (\$42). The best Dorper lambs (pictured below right) made \$160 (\$177) and were sold by B&S on account Blairfield Partnership.
