

From the Sheep Yards

Supply and demand continued to influence the market again this week with Tamworth reflecting the dearer trend across all NSW selling centres. As always, you can check out more photos on our TLSAA Facebook page.



Lambs

Older lambs topped at \$213 (\$207) for heavy lambs (pictured above) sold by DCM on account Tony and Kathy McCulloch, making them the best price lambs for 2017. Other good sales included: 65+kg lambs (pictured below left) sold by LMK on account R & G Webb for \$203 with the second cut making \$186; lambs sold by LMK on account Warren Hausfield made \$180; and the best PPA lambs made \$176. Suckers topped at \$150 (\$170) and shorn lambs topped at \$171. Dorper numbers were down again with the best lambs (pictured below right) making \$176.50 (\$170) for Allan Delve through CP. Other good results were B&S (\$172.50) and IML (\$161).

Lamb wrap

Lambs sold to \$213 (\$207) and averaged \$136 (\$122); suckers sold to \$150 (\$170) and averaged \$116 (\$150); hoggets sold to \$160 (\$127) and averaged \$124 (\$120).



Sheep

Sheep numbers were similar to last week with thumping big Dorper wethers sold by B&S making \$170; the best ewes made \$152 for crossbred ewes with 12 months wool sold by PPA; and Dorper hoggets sold by IML made \$145.

Sheep wrap

926 (612) ewes sold to \$152 (\$150) and averaged \$106 (\$102); wethers sold to \$170 (\$120) and averaged \$104 (\$80); rams sold to \$90 (\$50) and averaged \$75 (\$51).
