Congratulations to Wahnica Partnership who topped the market today with their lambs sold through CP making \$310, up from \$300 last week. Wheatcares also claimed another spot in the 300CLUB with their lambs sold through DC making \$308. The MLA reported ‘very strong gains for the plainest and lightest lambs returning to the paddock’ with firm to dearer market for heavy and extra heavy lambs and ‘restockers competed strongly on breeding age ewes.’”
