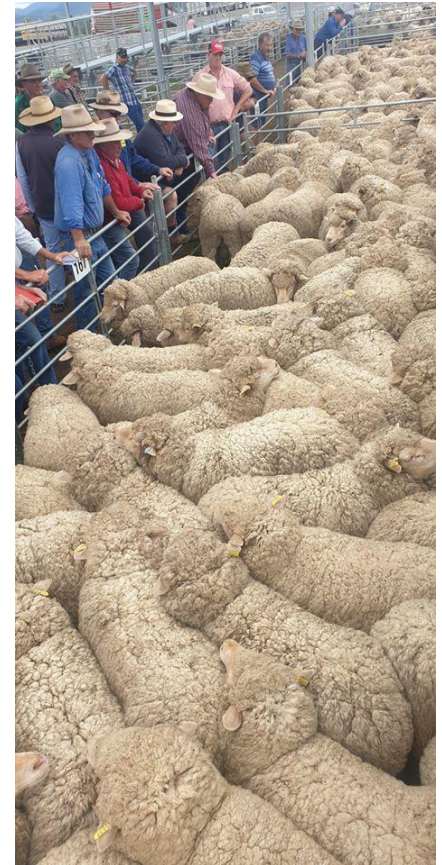
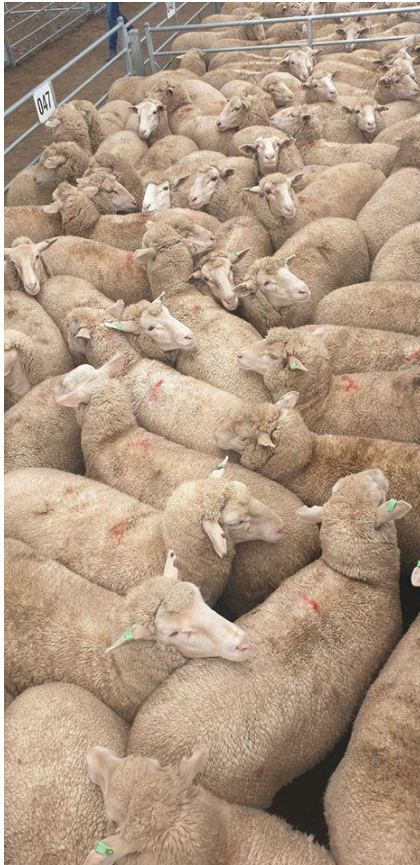




**Store lamb market continues to gain momentum**
