

Numbers well down mutton market still strong

A very small yarding today with limited numbers of both lambs and sheep. The best lambs were firm to softer, but the mutton market was described by one buyer as “extremely strong.” Shane Rule from Elders said there was good competition on both heavy and restocker lambs.
