

### Restocker activity spurs on market

Numbers remained low for sheep and lambs today with agents saying that heavy lambs were “firm to a tad dearer” and the re-stocker and mutton markets were very strong with “mutton hard to find.” A feature of the sale was a run of 550 September/October drop lambs (below left) by White Suffolk and Poll Dorset rams out of Nerstane blood Merino ewes. They were sold by RWL on account Braemar and made \$170- \$196.
