Sheep and lambs took a back seat to the cattle again today after a new record, but we did have a new vendor added to the 300 CLUB.

Bowler brothers, Wheatacres Partnership topped the sale with their lambs sold through Davidson Cameron making \$320. Congratulations on an outstanding job.

With lamb prices in the south rising to new highs, current record holder for Tamworth lambs, Peter Wiseman, reckons it won't be long before someone beats his record of \$354.

Heavy store lambs sold by Pitt Sons made \$169;

First of the NL lambs made \$238;

56 - 63 kg lambs sold by IML on account Craig Pike made \$260;

Darlissa and Burke Pastoral both made \$274 for their lambs sold through DC; and

The best of the GC lambs made \$282
