COVID 19 – and “putting clients first” - pays off in red hot market

COVID 19 – and putting clients first - paid off for Armidale vendors and livestock carriers, Jillian and Trevor Foley "Dallyn" Armidale (pictured below with agent Chris Paterson) who sold their outstanding Angus and Angus x vealers in a market the MLA quoted dearer than last week. Ironically, while much of their business involves transporting stock to Armidale, it also means that selling there is logistically difficult – when transporting clients' cattle is the priority there's little time to truck and sell their own. But the Foley's also made a conscious decision to sell through TRLX after an inspection last year impressed them. The Foley's said their August and October drop calves would normally be sold in May, but COVID 19 restrictions that limited access saw them hold on until they could see them sold. It was one of many highlights in a day of big results. A cow and calf unit sold by Pitt Sons came back at just under \$3500 for Rooganore Partnership, Warrah Ridge with the 842kg cow making \$1936 and the Angus x heifer calf making 380c/kg and tipping the scales at 398kg for a return of \$1512. The cow market was very strong despite the big numbers with a run of 240 cows and heifers sold by Elders on account RIFA Salutory topping at 311c/kg with the cows averaging \$1340.
