### Lambs

Older lambs sold to \$192 (\$194) for lambs sold by CP on account Wendouree. It's becoming a familiar story for the Dunne family who top the sale most times they send their lambs. Congratulations on another cracking pen of lambs.

Other good results included: \$188 for massive Cameron lambs sold by DCM; \$180 for Michael Fitzpatrick selling through IML; \$180 for the best of the PPA lambs; and \$172 for Gary Burgess for his lambs sold through IML. ### Lamb wrap

Lambs sold to \$192 (\$194) and averaged \$118 (\$121); and hoggets sold to \$105 (\$120) and averaged \$103 (\$88).

### Sheep wrap

Dorper ewes sold to \$125 (\$140) and averaged \$77 (\$98); Merino wethers sold to \$115 (\$134) and averaged \$105 (\$106); and Dorper ewes and lambs made \$110.
