There were plenty of sheep and lambs on offer in Tamworth today for the first sale of 2018, with prices similar to before Christmas and intense heat.



Lambs

Older lambs topped at \$200 for lambs sold by PPA on account Peter Toddkill. Sorry but we missed getting a photo of the top pen of lambs. Other good results included: Banoon Pastoral Co lambs (pictured above) sold by PPA made \$183; \$181 for beautiful lambs sold by G&C on account John McQueen, Loomberah; \$176 for the best of the DCM lambs; and \$170 for the first pen of the day sold by Angus Newcombe, now trading as Ray White Livestock (RWL), on account Spark.

Lamb wrap

Young lambs sold to \$168 (\$190); older lambs sold to \$200 (\$200); and hoggets sold to \$126 (\$150 last week) for Merino hoggets.

Sheep wrap

Ewes sold to \$137 (\$147 last sale); and wethers sold to \$150 (\$150 last sale).
