Numbers were down today with the very strong marketing continuing with the best results for lightweight vealer steers, heavy yearling steers and heifers and feeder steers.



STEERS

Vealer steers sold to 384c/kg (398c/kg), yearlings to 377c/kg (388c/kg) and grown steers to 378c/kg (372c/kg) for an outstanding run of steers sold by LMK on account Chaffey. Highlights included:

Yearling Angus steers (pictured above) sold by LMK on account Chaffey, Somerton sold to 378c/kg and the top pen averaged 509kg/\$1925;
