Lambs

Top price in the suckers was \$122 (\$135) for suckers (pictured top left) sold by G&C. Other highlights included suckers sold by PSPF on account Hunt for \$120 and 2nd x store lambs sold by PSPF for the same vendor made \$105. Suckers averaged \$80 (\$120) with 324 (401) sold.

The top pen of lambs (pictured middle left) made \$155 (\$155) for 57-67 kg lambs off the Lucerne, sold by Elders on account Weroona Partnership, Duri. Other highlights included the first pen of the day sold by DCM for \$145 and lambs sold by G&C on account John McQueen made the same money. 3338 (2681) lambs were sold for an average of \$107 (\$105).

The top shorn lambs made \$145 (\$144) and were sold by G&C on account Cameron Partnership. 261 (179) shorn lambs averaged \$118 (\$115).

The top Dorper lambs (pictured bottom left) made \$132 (\$152) (NA) and were sold by G&C on account CD & GE Walker.

Hoggets sold to \$92 (\$107) with 92 (385) sold and averaged \$73 (\$67).



Sheep

Wethers sold to \$89 (\$104) for a pen of Wiltipoll wethers sold by LMK on account Kerrina, Narrabri vendor and averaged \$70 (\$77.50) with 178 (123) sold. Ewes sold to \$79.50 (\$100) and averaged \$56 (\$64) with 855 (1045) sold.

Rams sold to \$100 (\$72) and averaged \$64.50 (\$70) with 98 (68) sold.
