

### From the Sheep Yards

**After weeks of cold, wet and wintry weather there was a touch of Spring in the air at TRLX with numbers largely unchanged from last week.**

#### LAMBS

Lambs sold to \$200 (\$203) with top price going to Tarakan Pastoral Co, Upper Horton for their heavy (60+kg) lambs (pictured below) sold through IML. Shorn lambs sold to \$158 (\$152) and were sold by DCM on account Cameron Partnership who also had the top price lambs last week and a limited number of hoggets sold to \$100 (\$122). Dorper lambs sold to \$146 (\$167).

#### SHEEP

Ewes sold to \$120 (\$123) and averaged \$56 with 333 sold. 33 (110) wethers sold to \$97 (\$120) and averaged \$85 (\$49) and 20 (33) rams sold to \$99 (\$105) and averaged \$66 (\$68).
