Lambs

Top price in the young lambs this week was \$144, well up on last week's top of \$126, for suckers sold by G&C on account Davidson.

Older lambs sold to \$145 (\$141) and were sold by IML on account G & L, Timbumburi. 2266 (2079) lambs averaged \$117 (\$98). The top Dorper lambs made \$135 (\$131) and were sold by CP on account RS & L Bianco.

The top shorn lambs made \$136 (\$127) and were sold by B&S on account Glen Lossie Partnership. Shorn lambs averaged \$115 (\$105). Hoggets sold to \$96 (\$98) and averaged \$81 (\$52).

Sheep

Ewes (pictured) sold to \$110 (\$90) for 1st x ewes, Aug shorn and sold by DCM on account JF Hombsch & Co. Older ewes sold to \$110. 1145 (1030) ewes averaged \$78 (\$57).

Wethers sold to \$101.50 (\$110) and averaged \$70 (\$73) with 443 sold. Rams sold to \$124 (\$67) and averaged \$81 (\$52) with 60 (151) sold.
