Lambs

Top price in the suckers was \$138 (\$122) for suckers sold by G&C on account JI & MH McLeod. Suckers averaged \$121 (\$80) with 177 (324) sold.

The top pen of lambs (pictured above) made \$150 (\$155) for the siblings to the Grand Champion pen at the recent Manilla Show. They were sold by B&S on account Robert Carey. Other highlights included lambs sold by B&S on account Burke Pastoral Co for \$147. 3445 (3338) lambs averaged \$105 (\$107).

The top shorn lambs made \$155 (\$145) and were sold by G&C on account JI & MH McLeod. 462 (261) shorn lambs averaged \$92 (\$118). Hoggets sold to \$97 (\$92) with 263 (92) sold for an average price of \$66 (\$73).

Sheep

Wethers sold to \$95 (\$89) and averaged \$66 (\$70) with 110 (178) sold.

Ewes sold to \$100 (\$79.50) and averaged \$58 (\$56) with 1618 (855) sold.
