Numbers were down despite a two week break with the weekend rain proving welcome change. Prices were generally up on the previous sale before Anzac Day.



LAMBS

Lambs sold to \$155 (\$148) and were sold by PPA on account GA & TJ McIlveen. Other highlights included lambs sold by CP on account Wendouree Grazing for \$154. 1724 (778) lambs averaged \$107 (\$105.00). The top Dorper lambs made \$140 (\$128) and were sold by LMK. The top shorn lambs made \$138 (\$138) and were sold by G&C on account McQueen. Shorn lambs averaged \$115 (\$112). Hoggets sold to \$120 (\$82) and averaged \$68 (\$78).

SHEEP

Young ewes sold to \$120 and older ewes sold to \$96 (\$104) and averaged \$65 (\$56) with 865 (574) sold. Ewes and lambs sold to \$101. Wethers sold to \$101 (\$92) and averaged \$81 (\$64) with 103 (721) sold. Rams sold to \$85 (\$78) and averaged \$85 (\$72) with 6 (62) sold.
