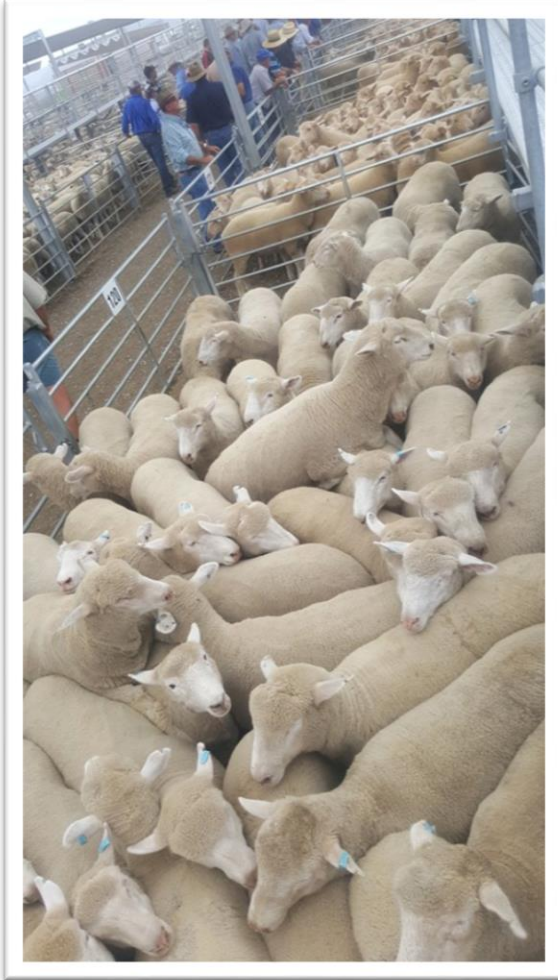


From the Sheep Yards



NUMBERS INCREASE FOLLOWING TWO WEEK BREAK FOR EASTER.

Lambs

Older lambs (pictured left) sold to \$154 (\$145) and were sold by CP on account Wendouree Grazing Co. 3974 (2266) lambs averaged \$102 (\$117). The top Dorper lambs (pictured bottom right) made \$150 (\$135) and were sold by LMK on account Cameron Barton. November drop, mixed sex store lambs (pictured bottom left) sold by PSPF on account Tim McGeoch made \$76.

The top shorn lambs made \$147 (\$136) and were sold by G&C on account John McQueen. Shorn lambs averaged \$114 (\$115). Hoggets sold to \$122 (\$96) and averaged \$63 (\$81).

Sheep

Young ewes sold to \$122 (\$110) and older ewes sold to \$110 (\$110). 1352 (1145) ewes averaged \$61 (\$78).

Wethers sold to \$120 (\$101.50) and averaged \$54 (\$70) with 416 (443) sold. Rams sold to \$100 (\$124) and averaged \$62 (\$81) with 74 (60) sold.
